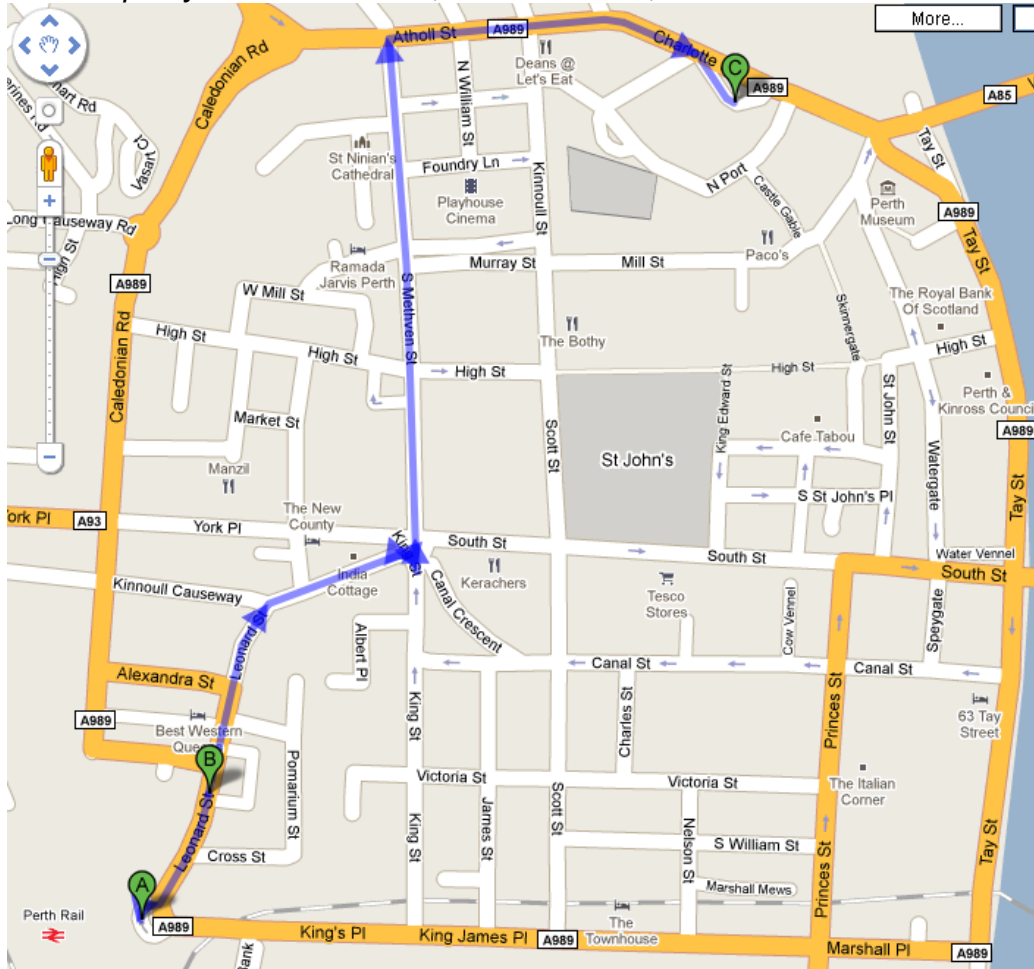

By train

Trains run to Perth approximately twice hourly from both Edinburgh and Glasgow train stations. From Aberdeen train station, trains run approximately hourly. If you are travelling from south of the border you may need to change at Edinburgh Waverley. The office is a 10-minute walk from the train station. To plan your train journey visit the [Trainline](#) or [National Express](#).

By bus

The cheapest way to travel to Perth is by bus. [Megabus](#) offers fares from as little as £1 from Scotland's major cities. Some of the buses stop at the Perth Park & Ride and there is a shuttle bus linking to the town centre. The office is a 10-minute walk from the bus station.

By car

If you can't come by public transport and need to drive, car parking is available near the office at the Kinnoull Street multi-storey car park. Parking areas and charges can be found [here](#). From the car park it is a 2-minute walk across to the office.

By bicycle

It is possible to reach the office by bike using the [National Cycle Network](#). We can provide covered cycle storage for a couple of bicycles. Bicycles can be carried free of charge on trains and some buses but advance booking is advised.
